#### A Contact information:

#### C Total amount due:

This section summarizes the total amount due on your electric bill and the due date. An automatic payment is indicated on the bill if you participate in this program.

#### D Billing summary:

Here you will find your past payments, current charges and the total charges due.



This comparison shows current energy use, the previous month's use and the previous year's use, along with the average use.

Explanation of charges:
